



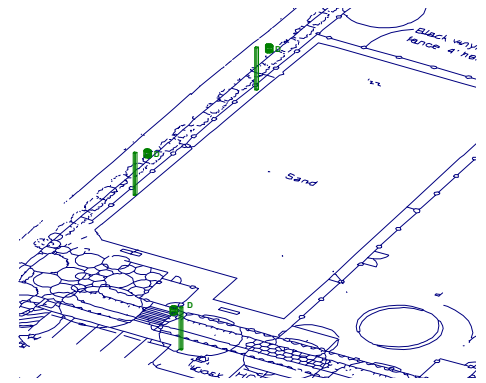
Hondo Dog Park

Winter Lighting Project

We are working to raise funds to install lighting in the winter area so park users can exercise their dogs later into the evening in winter!

Lighting Project Details

The proposed design for lighting will enable use of the dog park winter area for extended hours during the darker winter months. The design includes three lights that will illuminate the majority of the winter use area, as well as the parking near that area. This project has been proposed as a result of dog park user feedback for extended hours to exercise dogs during the winter, when it typically gets dark and the park closes around 5 pm.



How Can You Help? Sponsor a Bench!



Hondo Dog Park has various benches available for sponsorship for \$1500 each. All funds are paid to the City of Hillsboro and go into a special project fund for capital improvements to the dog park. Currently, these funds are going towards the lighting project described above.

About Hondo Dog Park

Hillsboro's first and only off-leash dog park opened in 2007 and is located near Hillsboro Stadium. Named in honor of Hillsboro Police K9 Dog Officer "Hondo" who lost his life in the line of duty in 1997, the park features nearly four acres of space, including a large mixed-size dog play area, a small/timid dog area, and a special winter use area.

Hillsboro Dog Association's Role



The Hillsboro Dog Association (HDA) is a 501(c)3 organization separate from the City of Hillsboro which is the official adopter of Hondo Dog Park. The mission of HDA is to enhance the quality of life of dogs and their owners through support of dog parks in the Hillsboro community. HDA members help with beautification projects at Hondo Dog Park and work to educate and serve as a

resource for dog park users. Volunteer members of the HDA are assisting the City in raising funds for the winter lighting project through bench sponsorship.

Sponsor a Bench!

There are many benches in the dog park available for sponsorship. The cost is \$1,500 per bench for the life of the bench (estimated at 15-20 years), and include a personalized plaque. Subject to Parks & Recreation Commission approval, plaques may say anything appropriate for a public park, such as the name of the sponsor, a business name (no company logos or slogans), a pet's name, or in memory of a loved one. A bench sponsorship is a donation to the City of Hillsboro, which is a tax-exempt organization, and depending on the donor's tax situation the donation may be tax-deductible.
