Hondo Dog Park Rules and Regulations:

Thank you for using the Hondo Dog Park. The success of this area will depend on compliance with owner's responsibilities. Failure to follow these responsibilities may result in the exclusion of non-complying users. More information is available at www.ci.hillsboro.or.us/ParksRec/. Thank you for your cooperation.

Owner Responsibilities:

This fenced area is for exercising dogs only and is used at your own risk. City of Hillsboro and Washington County will NOT be responsible for any damages or injuries.

1. Current dog license and vaccinations are required.
 - a. Health problems can spread quickly among dogs, so it is important to have your dog's vaccinations, including rabies, up to date. Failure to have your dog licensed may result in a fine.
 - b. It's recommended that puppies under six months of age do not use the Area. They may not have all of their vaccinations to play safely with other dogs.
 - c. Female dogs in heat are not allowed in the area (citable offense).
 - d. Bring only dogs in good health .
2. Clean up after your dog immediately and dispose in trash cans.
 - a. Please help by picking up what you see that others have missed.
 - b. Bring extra plastic bags from home to help us keep a plentiful supply.
3. Well-behaved dogs only. Dogs who exhibit dangerous behavior are prohibited.
 - a. Immediately stop aggressive behavior toward humans or dogs.
 - b. Remove your dog's halters, metal choke chains or link collars. These items may be dangerous to other dogs during play.
4. Do not leave your dog unattended.
 - a. Always keep an eye on your dog. Dangerous behavior can happen quickly. If your dog barks continuously or plays rough, please leash immediately and leave the Area. Barking uncontrollably can incite other dogs. If you would like information on how to socialize your aggressive dog, contact the Oregon Humane Society.
5. Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult.
 - a. Do not let children chase, yell, or otherwise incite dogs.
 - b. It is strongly recommended that no infants or strollers enter the Area for safety reasons.
6. No smoking, food, or alcohol inside Area.
7. No bicycle, skates, or skateboards inside the Area for safety reasons.
8. Other helpful tips:
 - a. Please keep your dog on-leash until you get inside the Off-leash Area.
 - b. Always open and close the Off-leash Area gates carefully, closing the first gate before opening the second gate.
 - c. Please call your dog away from the gate while other dogs are entering or leaving the Area.
