As you begin your discovery in learning the beauty of watercolor it is helpful to know that when you use quality paints, brushes, and paper your experience will be more successful and satisfying than if you use inferior or "student grade" materials. We will go over the supply list during the first class. Feel free to bring supplies that you already have.

Paper

- One sheet of 22" x 30" sheet of Arches 140 lb. cold pressed watercolor paper.

- Quinacridone Rose
- Azo Yellow
- Ultramarine Blue
- Payne's Gray

Brushes

- #6 and #8 round watercolor brushes

- Palette

- Approx. 20" x 16" double sided masonite board
