A day of volunteer service and a great outdoor recreation experience for the whole family.

Start the morning off enhancing Hamby Park by removing invasive plants, mulching along stream corridors, working on trails and planting native plants.

After the work is done, more fun begins! Participate in a variety of activities including:

- **Geocaching:** GPS units will be available to find hidden caches throughout the park.
- **Mountain bike clinics:** bikes and helmets available, or bring your own.
- **Disc golf clinics:** discs and instruction provided with free play time following. Bring your own discs or use ours.
- **Water quality station:** learn to measure dissolved oxygen and check turbidity and temperature. Discover the necessary qualities for healthy streams.
- **Arts & crafts:** create nature based arts and crafts.
- **Scavenger hunt:** have a blast in a park-based scavenger hunt.
- **New Playground:** be one of the first to play on the new Hamby Park nature-themed playground.



Snacks and fun handouts will be provided for the first 200 participants.

Gloves, tools and all necessary guidance will be provided. Wear sturdy shoes and dress for the weather. This event will take place rain or shine. Groups are welcome. Activities are appropriate for all ages, so bring the whole family!
